The very products and processes used to keep indoor environments clean may also contribute to indoor pollution. Studies show that in certain conditions many common products used for cleaning floors, surfaces and plumbing fixtures contain toxic contaminants at levels that pose risks to both human health and the environment. Symptoms can include eye, nose and throat irritation, headaches, dizziness and fatigue. Long-term environmental consequences, such as contamination of surface and ground water and bioaccumulation in plants and animals, can also occur when they are poured down drains.
