With water shortages a crisis in most of our capital cities, your business faces paying considerably more for water in the future. Cost-effective measures include water-conserving fixtures and plumbing such as reduced-flow taps, waterless urinals (which are more sanitary than standard ones) and low-flush toilets; using native and drought-tolerant plants in landscaping; irrigating with water recycled from sinks, basins and toilets; collecting rainwater for on-site use, and using green roofs, ponds and other water-catching features to manage rainwater run-off. The five-star 36/37 Squadron Headquarters at the RAAF Richmond airbase used all these strategies to achieve a maximum score for water conservation in office design. The building uses half the potable water of similar premises.
