A waste audit helps your business understand the nature of its waste streams and the different options for transforming them into something useful. By closing the production loop you maximise resources, reduce waste-disposal costs and create a more efficient organisation. An audit involves collecting all waste generated over a week then sorting through it to determine composition, quantities and the effectiveness of existing waste-management strategies. For best results you need well-defined objectives, committed management and a plan that gives ownership to those who will implement systems and strategies.
